#### Holy Spirit

- Just like God the Father and God the Son, the Holy Spirit is fully God. He is an equal member of the Trinity. (Acts 5:3-4)
- The Holy Spirit is God. He helped God the Father and God the Son in creating the world. (Job 33:4, Psalm 104:30)
- The Holy Spirit was in charge of Jesus' birth. He finished that work and brought forth a perfect Baby (Jesus). (Luke 1:35)
- The Holy Spirit was in charge of a special book. He finished that work and brought forth a perfect Bible. (2 Peter 1:20-21)
- The Holy Spirit is in charge of a special bride (the church). His work will bring forth a perfect bride (Bride of Christ). (Ephesians 5:25-27)
- The Holy Spirit invites sinners to be saved. He convicts the heart of the sinner about the gospel. (John 16:7-8)
- The Holy Spirit lives and works in the life of every Christian. He works to sanctify each Christian. (1Cor. 3:16, Galatians 5:16, 1 Thes 5:23)
- The Holy Spirit fills Christians to serve the Lord. He empowers Christians to serve their Lord. (1 Cor 2:4-5, Eph 5:18)

#### Angels, Demons, Satan

- Angels are heavenly beings that God created. (Nehemiah 9:6, Psa 148: 2 & 5)
- Holy Angels give praise to God, serve God, and minister to God's children. (Psalm 103:20-21, Heb. 1:14)
- Satan was once a great Angel who became proud, sinned, and was cast out of Heaven by God. (Isaiah 14:12-13)
- Since his fall, Satan causes us to doubt God's Word, tempts us to sin, and destroys lives. (John 8:44)
- Satan is called the God of this world and the whole world is under his influence. (2 Corinthians 4:4, 1 John 5:19)
- Demons fell with Satan. They twist the truth, possess unsaved people, and try to harm people. (Revelation 12:9, 1 Timothy 4:1)
- God is much stronger and more powerful than Satan and his Demons. (1 John 4:4)
- Satan and his demons will be punished forever when Jesus returns. (Matthew 25:41, Revelation 20:10)

### God's Law

- God's law is a reminder of how holy and righteous God is. It shows us His Holiness. (Matthew 5:48, 1 Peter 1:15)
- God's law teaches the world all about what sin is. Sin is failing to live perfectly which is what God requires. (Romans 7:7)
- God's law shows us how perfect Jesus was. Jesus never broke God's law. (Hebrews 7:25-26)
- God's law shows us our own sinfulness. No matter how hard we try, we cannot keep the law completely. (Galatians 3:24-25)
- God's law shows us our need for Jesus. Jesus is the only one who can make us righteous before God. (Philippians 3:9, Gal 2:16)
- God's law shows us how to live our lives. The first four of the commandments show us our duty to God. (Exodus 20:3-4, Ex 20:7-8)

# God's Law (continued)

- God's law shows us how to live our lives. The last six of the commandments show us our duty to others. (Exodus 20:13-17)
- Following God's law brings more joy than going our own way. Obeying God's law is always for our good. (Deut. 6:24, 1 John 5:3)

## The Church

- The founder of the New Testament church is Jesus. He is the one who set it all up. It is His church. (Matt. 16:15-18)
- The Head of the Church is Jesus Christ. He controls it and he is the whole reason for it. (Col 1:18, 1 Cor 3:11)
- The Church is called the Bride of Christ. The Holy Spirit is preparing the church to meet Jesus. (Rev 19:7-8)
- The universal church is made up of all Christians around the world and those in heaven. (1 Cor 12:12, 1 Cor 12:27)
- The local church is made up of Christians who live in a certain area and worship God together. (Hebrews 10:25, Matthew 18:20)
- The church was created to exalt the Savior. The church's main purpose is to glorify God in all it does. (1 Peter 2:5, Psalm 22:22)
- The church was created to edify the saint. The church teaches Christians and helps them grow strong. (1 peter 5:2, Ephesians 4:11-12)
- The church was created to evangelize the sinner. The church works to reach the lost with the gospel. (Mark 16:15, 1 peter 3:15)

## Future Events

- Jesus will return and meet Christians in the air (the Rapture). He will take all Christians on Earth to Heaven. (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17)
- Raptured Christians will be taken to the Judgment Seat of Christ. There they will be rewarded for their service to the Lord. (2 Corinthians 5:9-10)
- Christian's will be given a new heavenly body during the rapture. (1 Corinthians 15:51-52)
- People on Earth will go through terrible judgements from God during seven years of Tribulation. (Matthew 24:21)
- o Jesus will come back and reign on Earth for 1,000 years. (Revelation 20:6)
- God will judge all unbelievers at the Great White Throne Judgment. All of them will be sent to the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:11–12)
- God will set up a new Heaven and a new Earth in a New Jerusalem (Rev. 21:1-2)
- Christians need to be ready for the return of the Lord Jesus Christ, and busy warning others of His coming. (Mark 13:35-36, 1 John 2:28)

# • Future Events

- When people die their body returns to dust, but their spirit will go either to heaven or Hell (Genesis 3:19, John 5:28-29)
- Hell is a place of eternal punishment. (Revelation 20:15, Psalm 9:17)
- Heaven is a place of eternal reward. It is a perfect and joyful home. (Psalm 16:11, Revelation 7:16-17)
